Clean Energy Future plan

- The Indigenous Carbon Farming Fund (ICFF) is part of the Government's Clean Energy Future plan.
- It supports Indigenous participation in the Carbon Farming Initiative (CFI).
- The CFI allows farmers and land managers to earn carbon credits by storing carbon or reducing greenhouse gas emissions on the land.
 - These credits can then be sold to people and businesses wishing to offset their emissions.

Indigenous Carbon Farming Fund (ICFF)

- The ICFF has 2 streams:
 - A \$17.1 million Capacity Building and Business
 Support stream to help Indigenous communities
 establish or participate in carbon farming projects.
 - A \$5.2 million Research and Development (R&D) stream for research and tools to develop and implement low-cost CFI methodologies which support high Indigenous participation.
- SavBAT was one of 5 projects funded under the first round of the R&D stream.

SavBAT and Indigenous CFI participation

- The approved CFI savanna burning methodology requires a series of complex calculations for estimating greenhouse gas emissions and their abatement.
- SavBAT will support Indigenous participation in the CFI through reducing technical barriers and transaction costs.
